Day 1: HOME CITY - BUENOS AIRES

Day 2: BUENOS AIRES - CITY TOUR

Nearby is the Cathedral where the remains of Argentina's greatest national hero the liberator General San Martin lie. Then to the colorful Boca district and funky out-door art museum. City Tour (Private Car): \$89.00 Per Person

Lovely three hour comprehensive tour of Buenos Aires, Argentina's vibrant, cosmopolitan, European style capital city, a combination of wide tree-lined boulevards, sidewalk cafes, pedestrian malls, wonderful turn of the century architecture and the best people watching in the continent. Depart from your hotel for Avenida 9 de Julio, the world's widest boulevard, passing the famous Colon Opera House, the Obelisk commemorating the founding of the city in 1536, on route to the famous Plaza de Mayo. This impressive square is bordered by The Cabildo, the old town hall dating to 1751, the Casa Rosada, the Seat of Government, and the Cathedral housing the Mausoleum of General San Martin, the nation's greatest hero from the War of Independence in the early 1800's. The tour continues to the colorful district La Boca, an area greatly influenced by the Italian immigrants who settled there, and the brightly painted homes of Caminito street. Then to the Buenos Aires port area and the remodeled area of Puerto Madero with its lively coffee houses and restaurants. Continuing to San Martin Square towards the attractive Palermo Chico residential district and Palermo Park with its colorful jacaranda and palo borracho trees which flower in spring and late summer. Continuing to the elegant district of Recoleta for a visit to Recoleta Museum where the rich and famous including Evita Peron are laid to rest.

Tigre and Parana River Delta (Private Car): \$115.00 Per Person

Lovely four hour driving tour through the elegant riverside suburbs of Olivos, San Isidro and San Fernando on route to Tigre, one of the most charming resorts near Buenos Aires, with many rowing and yacht clubs, summer residences and riverside restaurants. A relaxing one hour cruise follows as you emander along the channels of the Parana River for close up look at the unique delta that ends at the Rio de la Plata, the widest river in the world.
